## Hometown Hero Banner Project for Middleport, New York

Many towns and villages throughout the state have taken the opportunity to thank the servicemen and servicewomen who served in the US Armed Forces by displaying banners with their photos. Middleport had four very successful years with some 135 banners displayed throughout the village. These banners were purchased by their families or friends and then were prominently displayed through the summer months on various streets throughout the community. I have been asked if the program is going to continue for the 2024 season and I would be happy to once again run the program if there is enough interest.

# **Banner Information**

The banners are 30" by 60", double sided photo, vinyl material and will include the following factual information: Name of the serviceman/woman; branch of service; era of service and any special honors; names of the donors. Banners will be displayed on poles located on Main, State, Vernon, Park, Church and other main routes through the village. They will hang from Memorial Day through Veteran's Day and then stored for the winter, to be hung again the following year. THE PLACEMENT WILL BE RANDOM AND WE CANNOT HONOR REQUESTS FOR LOCATIONS. Depending on demand, the number of banners purchased for 2024 will be capped off at 50. At the end of the season, banners will be stored in the Village Hall but families may request the return of their banner after Veteran's Day.

# Requirements

All service men and women must meet these requirements:

- 1. Have resided within the village limits of Middleport, New York presently or at some time in their lifetime
- 2. Served or are serving our country in Army, Air Force, Coast Guard, National Guard, Marines or Navy
- 3. Must be presently serving, or be an honorably discharged veteran, or MIA or died in the line of duty.

## **Banner Pricing**

Each banner will cost family/friend a total of \$200, which includes the double sided vinyl banner, hardware for hanging and storage. The banner is the property of the family and can be returned to them if requested at the end of each season. The company suggests a three year guarantee for the banner.

## Sponsorship

For individuals or businesses who would like to be a sponsor without purchasing a banner, monetary donations are gratefully accepted and will be used for expenses beyond the cost of the banners and hardware.

#### All servicemen/servicewomen must have the following qualifications:

- 1. Resided within the *Village of Middleport*, NY presently or at some time in their lifetime.
- 2. Served or serving our country in one of the following: Army, Air Force, Coast Guard, National Guard, Marines or Navy.
- 3. Each serviceman/servicewoman must be presently serving, or be an honorably discharged veteran, MIA or died in the line of duty.

Persian Gulf War- August 2, 1990 – 2021 (Afghanistan, Iraq) Conflicts in Panama, Grenada, Lebanon Viet Nam – August 5, 1964 -May 7, 1975 Korea – June 27,1950 – January 31, 1955 WWII – December 7, 1941 – December 31, 1946 WWI – April 6, 1917 – November 11, 1918 Civil War 1861 – 1865 Peacetime (enter dates of service)

#### **Banner Pricing**

The cost of the banner and hardware is \$200 which includes the double sided vinyl banner, appropriate hardware and storage of the banner. Depending on demand, orders this year are limited to 50. All orders and payment are due by November 30,2023. January will be the time all banners are prepared for production by Rileighs Outdoor Décor, giving time for inspection and editing if necessary. Payment by check must be enclosed and payable to **Village of Middleport Hometown Heroes Project**. Please write the name of your veteran on the memo section of your check.

#### Photo for the Banner

You will supply the photo of the veteran in uniform that you wish to appear on the banner. Pictures will be scanned and returned to you once the banner is approved. **Please attach a self-addressed stamped envelope to return the photo to you.** You may also send an electronic photo but please make sure that it has been scanned at the highest resolution possible. Also, please make sure to sign the photo release on the application so we can use the photo for publicity purposes if necessary.
