NOTICE

The resolution, a summary of which is published herewith, has been adopted on June 18, 2025, and an abstract thereof has been published and posted as required by law and the period of time has elapsed for the submission and filing of a petition for a permissive referendum and a valid petition has not been submitted and filed. The validity of the obligations authorized by such resolution may be hereafter contested only if such obligations were authorized for an object or purpose for which the Village of Middleport, in the County of Niagara, New York, is not authorized to expend money or if the provisions of law which should have been complied with as of the date of publication of this notice were not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty days after the date of publication of the notice, or such obligations were authorized in violation of the provisions of the constitution.

BOND RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF MIDDLEPORT, NEW YORK, ADOPTED JUNE 18, 2025, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS IN A PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$325,000 TO FINANCE WASTEWATER PUMP STATION IMPROVEMENTS, STATING THE ESTIMATED MAXIMUM COST THEREOF IS \$325,000 AND APPROPRIATING SAID AMOUNT FOR SUCH PURPOSE

The object or purpose for which the bond are authorized is the construction of improvements to the Hammond Parkway Wastewater Pump Station and the Sherman Road Wastewater Pump Station, and the acquisition and installation of a portable generator for use at both pump stations, and any other ancillary or related work in connection therewith, at the estimated maximum cost of \$325,000, all as described in the report prepared for the Village by Wendel, duly licensed engineers.

The amount of obligations to be issued is \$325,000.

The period of probable usefulness is forty (40) years.

A complete copy of the bond resolution summarized above shall be available for public inspection during normal business hours at the office of the Village Clerk, at the Village Hall, 24 Main Street, Middleport, New York.
